


1. Has Jay'Den been adjudged to be in need of protection or services and placed outside the home for a cumulative period of six months or longer pursuant to one or more court orders containing the termination of parental rights notice by law?

2. Did Anytown County Department of Social Services make a reasonable effort to provide the services ordered by the court?

3. Has Tanya Hess failed to meet the conditions established for the safe return of Jay'Den to Tanya's home?

4. Is there a substantial likelihood that Tanya Hess will not meet these conditions within the nine-month period following the conclusion of this hearing?

Defense

- 1. She met the conditions
- 2. She didn't meet the conditions because no reasonable efforts
- 3. She didn't meet the conditions but she will within 9 months
